The purchase agreement was signed on 11 December 2019, and the Coesfeld-based Lauer company with 15 employees was taken over by the renowned control and automation specialist Lebbing. For 25 years, Ingenieurbüro Lauer has been an expert in all aspects of CE marking & risk assessment.

The takeover means that the Bocholt experts now have a competent partner for safety analyses and CE certification, so that customers can be offered an integrated and coordinated solution portfolio in the future. All employees of Ingenieurbüro Lauer will be taken over and the previous range of services of the company will be maintained.
